In 2006, Pam was honored as a finalist for the ATHENA Award of Beaver County, sponsored by the Beaver Valley Business and Professional Women/USA. In a profile, the *Beaver County Times* praised her work to provide "support and assistance for entrepreneurial and established women-owned businesses" and said that one of her clients publicly said she wished she would have had the guidance of Pam and the firm when she first started her business.
